Activity: Education Plan

Lesson Time	10-15 minutes
Materials	 Papers Pens Board Markers to write on the board
Practice	1. Write "Study" and "Work" on separate sides of the board.
	 Elicit from participants the benefits they will gain from studying and from working. Write responses on the board.
	3. Ask participants what children should focus on first: work or study. What should adults focus on first? (For children, education should be the first priority; for adults, work should be the top priority.)
	4. Ask participants to write down their own education plan.
	5. Let some participants share their plans and, as a class, discuss whether that plan is realistic or not.

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
